

## Local Rules

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)

- (a) All ground outside boundaries to the course defined by white stakes and/or lines.
- (b) Beyond any cliff edge, fence or hedge bounding the course.
- (c) In or beyond any ditch bounding the course.
- (d) Within the circled area of the Greenkeepers' compound (Holes 1, 2 and 11).
- (e) On or beyond the driveway to the car park.
- (f) A ball which crosses the Wirral Way and comes to rest beyond it, is out of bounds, even though it may be on another part of the course.

### 2. CLIFF EDGES (Compulsory Relief)

A ball coming to rest within one club-length of the cliff edge must be lifted and dropped, without penalty, one further club-length away from the cliff edge and not nearer the hole.

### 3. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26-1)

- (a) All water hazards are defined by yellow stakes and/or lines.
- (b) All lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes and/or lines.

### 4. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

### 5. ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS (Rule 25-1)

- (a) All areas defined by blue stakes and/or lines.
- (b) Vehicle wheel tracks and ruts may be treated as ground under repair.

### 6. WATERING SYSTEM (Rule 24-2)

Pop up sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24.2. In addition, if the player's ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief, without penalty, as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that is (a) not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

### 7. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)

- (a) Relief must be taken from staked trees which interfere with the stance or area of intended swing.
- (b) The struts to the fence behind the 6th green, all drainage and irrigation covers are all immovable obstructions.

### 8. DISTANCE - MEASURING DEVICES (Rule 14-3)

For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc) the player is in breach of rule 14-3 for which the penalty is Match play - Loss of hole, Stroke play - Two strokes. For subsequent offences - Disqualification.

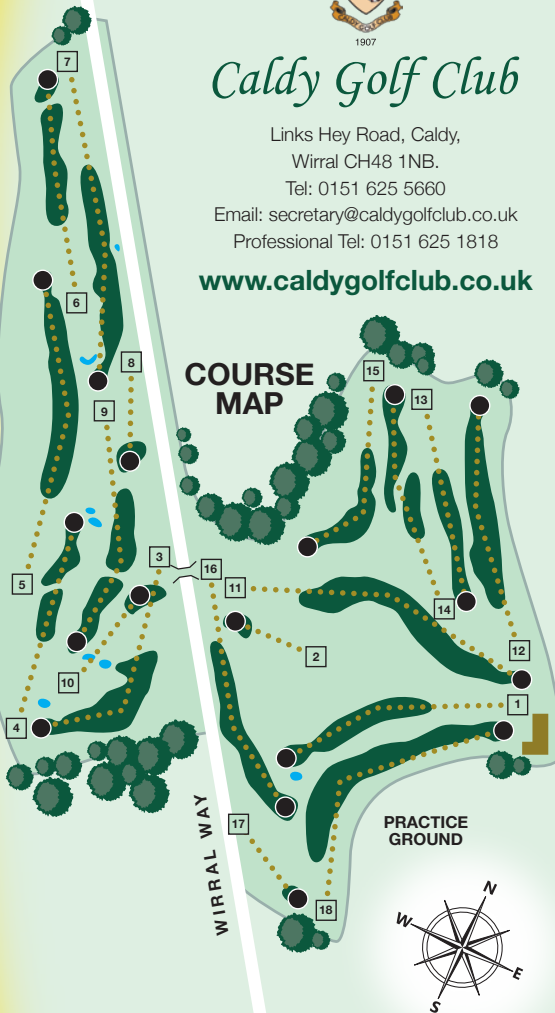
### 9. BUNKER FACES

The face of a bunker which consists of stacked turf is neither (a) part of the hazard, nor (b) a "closely-mown area" under Rule 25-2

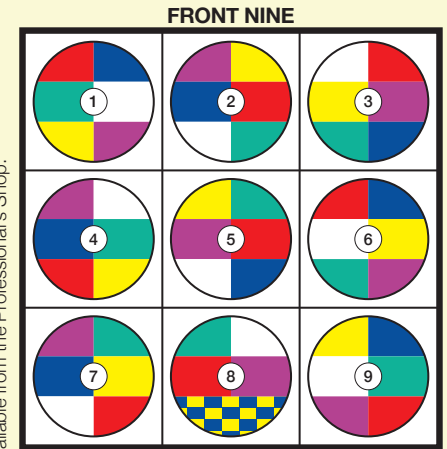

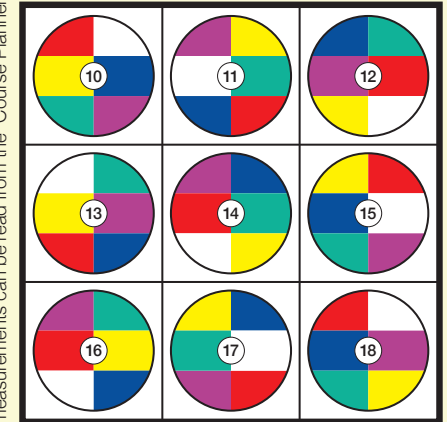

The pin positions on the greens correspond to the daily colour displayed on the notice board alongside the Professional's Shop. Example: If the daily colour was red, the pin on the 1st would be back left. Further course measurements can be read from the 'Course Planner' available from the Professional's Shop.



### BACK NINE



Marker Posts are 150 yards from the centre of the green. For all play, a player may obtain distance information by using a device which: Measures distance only. See Local Rule 8.

### COURSE HEALTH & SAFETY NOTES

Be aware of greens staff who have priority when working on the course, they will move aside as soon as possible. Observe on-course notices and exercise due caution at all times.

1. Players must not tee-off if any players or greens staff are within range.
2. Take care when players or greens staff are on adjacent holes or practice areas.
3. Members of the public walk on the Wirral Way, which traverses the course.
4. Players putting out on the 10th green, have priority over players on the 3rd tee.
5. Members of the public walk near the cliffs and use the car park beyond the 6th green fencing.
6. Buggies must be driven with caution on ramps and across bridges. They must not be driven across the ditch before the 6th green.
