CALDY GOLF CLUB – VISITOR GUIDELINES

We are delighted to welcome all Visitors to Caldy Golf Club and do hope that you enjoy your time spent with us.

Due to the necessary restrictions placed upon us by the current Covid-19 situation, we would like to draw your attention to the following information in advance of your visit.

1. Players must change in the car park and have all their equipment with them.
2. Visitors may use their own manual or electric trolley. A limited number of sterilised trolley handles will be available from the Club Professional.
3. A very small number of rental buggy's are available on a first come first served basis by prior arrangement with the Professional.
4. The practice putting green will be open however there will be no flags or holes so we encourage Visitors to place a tee in the ground as a target. A maximum of 4 players may utilise the practice putting green at any given time (2 on the upper and 2 on the lower level). The putting green should only be utilised for 10 to 15 mins maximum prior to your tee time.
5. In a similar way, the chipping green may be utilised prior to your round by a maximum of 2 people at any given time.
6. Please arrive at the 1st tee no more than 5 mins before your start time and only 1 player must be on the tee box at any time.
7. Visitors must uphold the mandatory 2 metre physical distancing measures at all times.

8. ON THE COURSE – Please note:- - There will be no rakes in bunkers. - Visitors are asked to utilise either a Club or their foot to repair the bunker as best they can after play. - Should a Visitor wish to do so, they may lift and place their ball in the bunker within 6 inches and no closer to the hole.
9. Water fountains, ball washers, shoe cleaners and benches around the course will not be in use.
10. On the Green please do not touch the flagstick. Holes have been adapted to allow easy removal of your golf ball.
11. Social distancing must be adhered to at all times and there should be no handshakes on completion of play.

FACILITIES AND GENERAL ADVICE

1. Please note that the Clubhouse is now open with the appropriate social appropriate distancing measures in place. The Offices and Administration areas are not available for Visitors to visit. Should you wish to contact the Administration team, please do so via phone and/or email. When entering the club house via the hallway please ensure you complete the Track & Trace registration form which is on the desk together with hand sanitizer.
2. Toilets may be used in the Ladies & Gents Locker rooms, but lockers, locker rooms and showers will remain closed. Only enter the locker rooms if you need to use the toilet facilities. Please note that the on course toilet will not be available during this period.
3. Please observe the protocols for entering and exiting the Professional Shop as detailed at the entrance area. Please ensure you wear a mask on entering the Pro Shop.
4. The hut at the 11th green will also remain closed.
5. The compressors/shoe cleaning facility will not be available for use.

Visitors are respectfully requested to adhere to the conditions outlined at all times. The Club and our Staff are doing all that we can to ensure your safety and wellbeing and your compliance with these necessary restrictions is much appreciated. Should

any Visitor observe any activity from another Visitor which does not adhere to these policies, they are urged to politely remind them of their responsibilities.
